

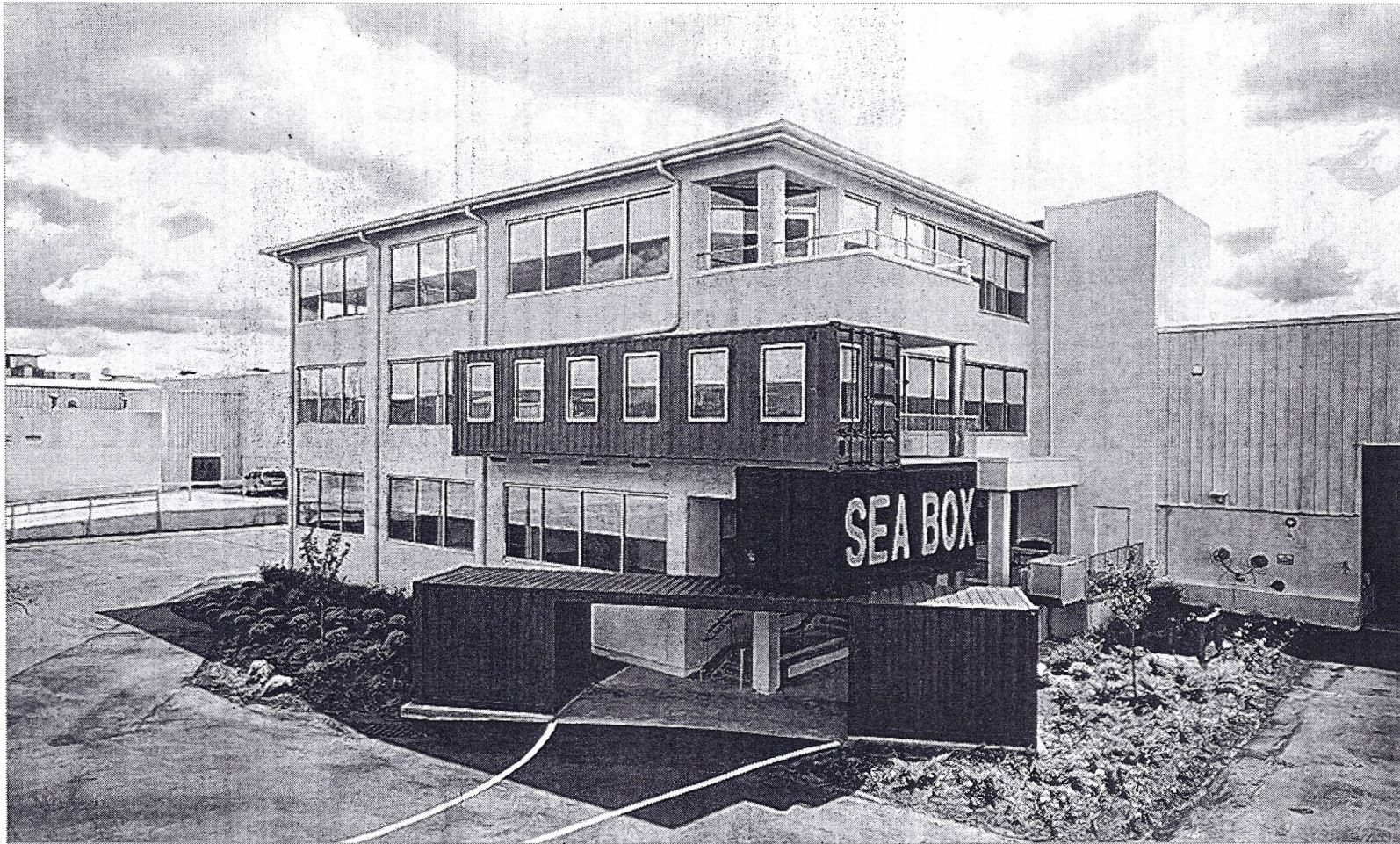
Holliday Architects takes honors at MAME Awards
